What: *the following activities will be done*

SKILL BUILDER

- Hand made paper – each girl keeps their own
- A paper cutting project and information about how this craft would be used in other cultures
- An origami project

TECHNOLOGY

- Review the papermaking process using model machines and videos. And we will compare the hand-making process with the machine made process.
- Review the paper making timeline which indicates major milestones and inventions to paper making technology.
- Discuss materials which go into paper and the processes which lead to different uses (such as acid free, starch additives, etc)
- Show various paper products in our gift shop and discuss pricing, packaging, etc.

SERVICE PROJECTS

- A craft project using recycled phone book yellow pages.
- If the troop would like, they can enhance the paper they make with a theme (ie. Christmas / Holiday or Veteran's Day) and then turn their paper into cards. We need to know this in advance.

CAREER EXPLORATION

- At least 2 females who currently work in the paper-related industry will talk about careers and answer questions. Additionally, our 2 educators, myself and Kathy Kleman, have degrees in chemical engineering and worked for paper companies.
